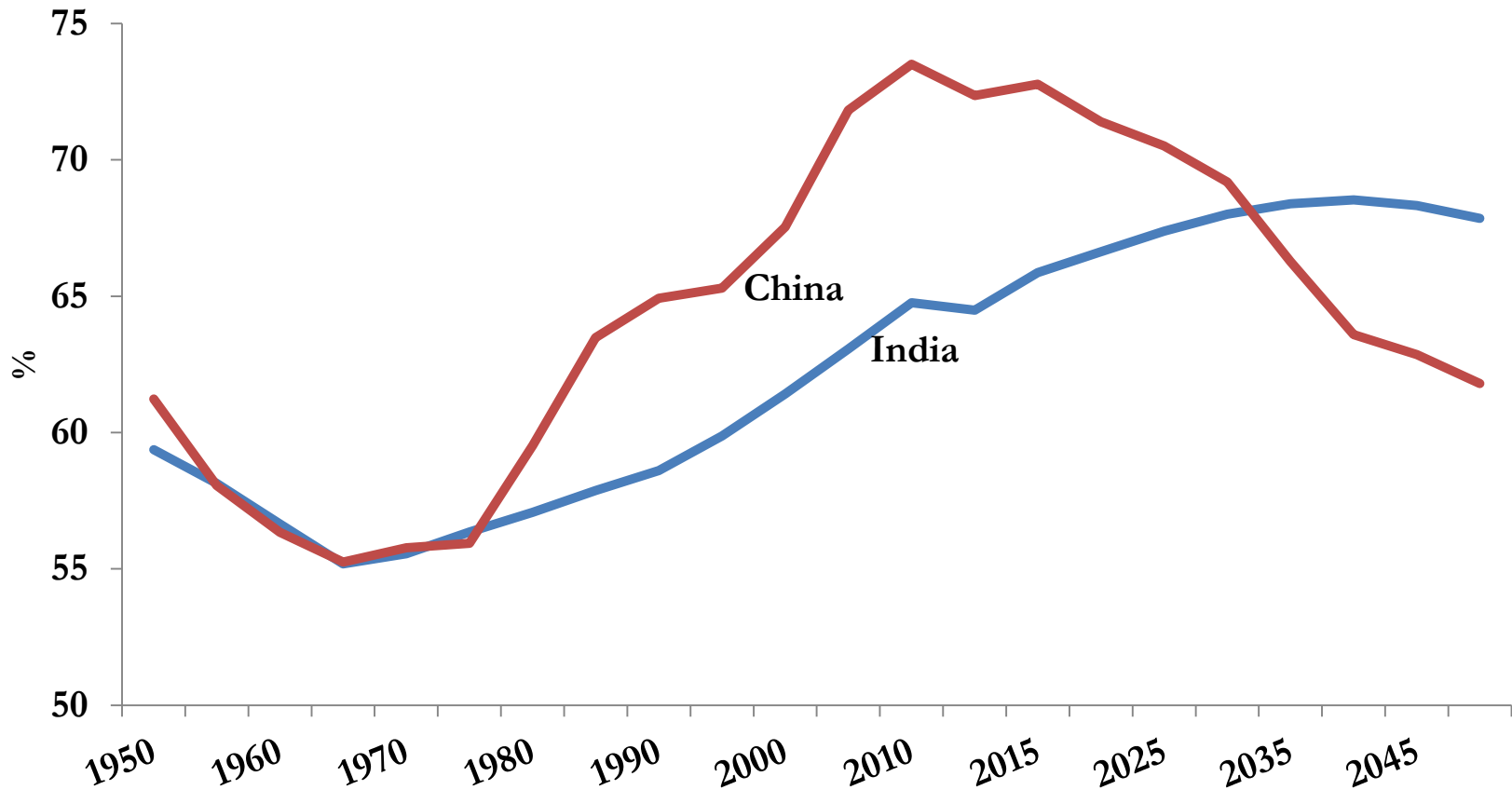
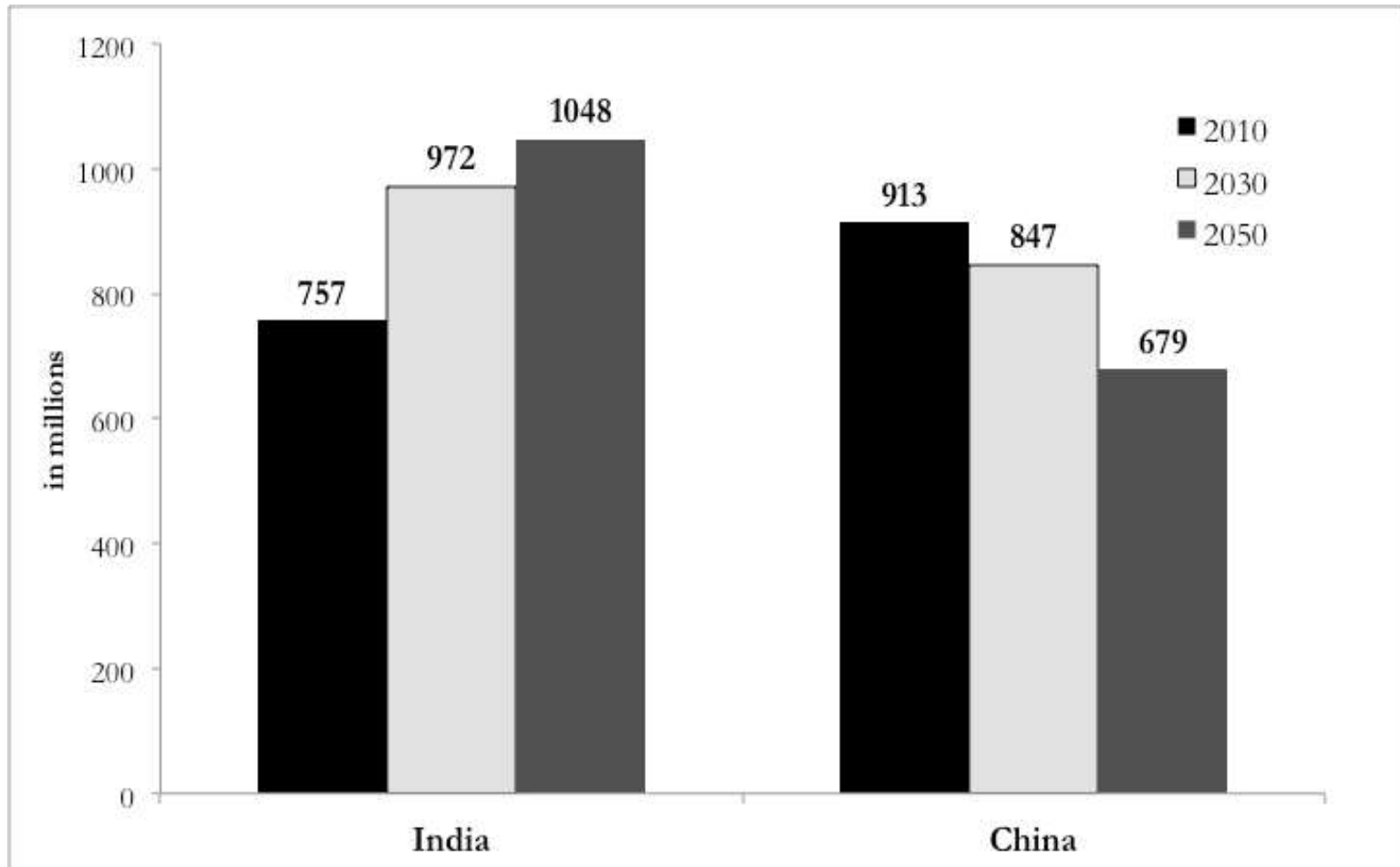


# Population in the 15-64 age group as a % of total population
